

A RESOLUTION concurring with the Barton Springs/Edwards  
Aquifer Conservation District resolution to remove land in  
Bastrop County from overlapping with the Lost Pines Groundwater  
Conservation District

WHEREAS, when the Barton Springs/Edwards Aquifer Conservation District was created, its boundaries were composed of the territory described by an order of the Texas Water Commission dated August 15, 1986, which may have been modified by Subchapter J, Chapter 36, Texas Water Code, or other law; and,

WHEREAS, as defined, the the Barton Springs/Edward Aquifer Conservation District included approximately 410 acres of land within the Creedmore-Maha Water Supply Corporation certificate of convenience and necessity located in Bastrop County; and,

WHEREAS, the Lost Pines Groundwater Conservation District (the "District") was created in 1997 with boundaries coextensive with the boundaries of Bastrop and Lee Counties, thereby creating an overlap to the extent of the 410 acres; And,

WHEREAS, the Barton Springs/Edwards Aquifer Conservation District has adopted Resolution No. 092310-01, requesting the 82<sup>nd</sup> Session of the Legislature to amend its jurisdictional boundaries so as to exclude from its jurisdiction any area that is recognized to be in Bastrop County, namely the 410 acres of land; and,

WHEREAS, the District has reviewed the Barton Springs/Edwards Aquifer Conservation District's resolution and facts presented, and concurs with the resolution's import.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LOST PINES GROUNDWATER CONSERVATION DISTRICT THAT:

The District concurs with the Barton Springs/Edwards Aquifer Conservation District's Resolution No. 092310-01 and recommends that the overlap be removed;

The Secretary of the District is directed to forward a copy of this resolution to the Honorable Glenn Hagar, Senator for District 18, and the Honorable Tim Kleinschmidt, State Representative for District 17, whose district's includes this area; and a copy to the Barton Springs/Edwards Aquifer Conservation District.
